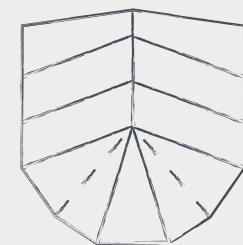

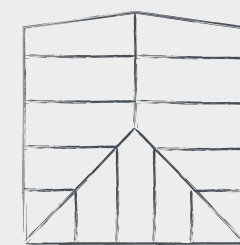

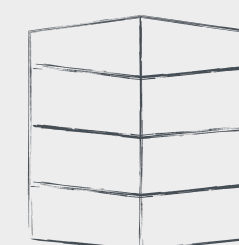
VICTORIAN

Typically features a bay-window style front with either 3 or 5 windows and a steep pitched roof with ornate ridge detail.



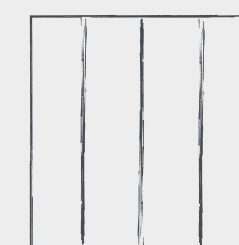
EDWARDIAN

...or Georgian. Square or rectangular in shape, this imposing style with a steep pitched roof allows you to maximise space while maintaining character.



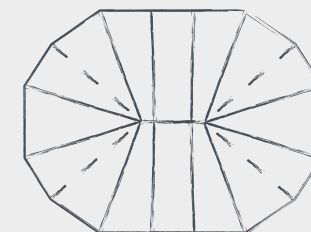
GABLE

The traditional apex roof combined with a fully glazed front elevation floods your room with natural light.



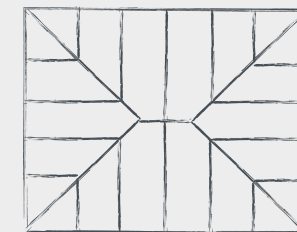
LEAN-TO

Perfect to make the most of your additional space! The shallower variable pitch, makes them ideal for homes with limited space under the eaves.



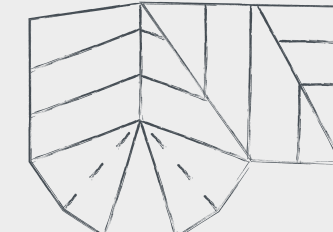
DOUBLE HIPPED VICTORIAN

The same as a Victorian, but imagine them pushed together! With 3 facets on either side and a steep pitched roof with ornate ridge detail.



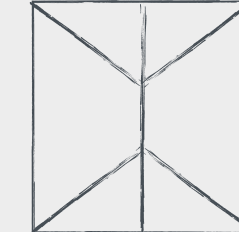
DOUBLE HIPPED EDWARDIAN

SOLID TILED ROOF

Solid roof conservatories create the sophisticated ambience of an extension, without the cost. A solid roof breathes life back into your home, creating a year-round ambient space whilst being a worthwhile investment.

An extension and conservatory combined – a solid roof conservatory is the ideal solution to wanting additional space that offers sound and heat insulation properties far superior to glass and polycarbonate. Whats more, they blend seamlessly and stylishly with the rest of your house to look as if it has always been part of the building.

They can also easily be retrofitted to existing conservatories, meaning an old glass or polycarbonate conservatory can easily be upgraded, without the cost of a whole new conservatory. Choose rooflights to maximise the amount of natural light in a room. The sash can be rotated through 180° and locked, allowing easy and safe cleaning. Or why not choose a lantern? Our SOLapex range can be combined with a solid roof for a orangery style focal point.





ORANGERY ROOF

An orangery is a great middle ground between a conservatory and extension, with their combination of brick pillars and glass. They are often used as a separate living space, whether a dining room, living room or playroom. Often people use them as an extension to their kitchens and make a huge family room.

We class an orangery as a home extension with a roof that has glass covering less than 75% of the area, and less than 50% of the total wall area is made up of brickwork. The feature brickwork really helps your new room to stand out, and the lantern roof allows natural light to spill in. The pelmet around the perimeter gives you the opportunity for those finishing touches such as spotlights or speakers. You can easily see why an orangery creates a seamless link between your home and garden.

Add classic French doors, space-saving sliding patio doors or bi-fold doors for uninterrupted garden views. Orangeries are the perfect way to get the true feel of an extension - without the cost.



SOLID GLAZED ROOF

In fact, new windows and doors are made from up to 50% sustainable PVCu and additional components being 100% recyclable. We also have invested in our own glass crusher, enabling us to compact it and send it away to be recycled.



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
